2013 Milano Design PhD Festival: Call for Video

We invite PhD candidates, researchers and professors to submit a **60 seconds video** for the **Video Session of the Second Edition of the Milano Design PhD Festival**, with the goal of:

- **showing** a panorama about results and on-going works of design research in the Festival Thematic Areas;
- **exploring** videos as contemporary tool for communication and divulgation of research's contents;
- **experiencing** an international networking context.

Video might describe recently completed work, highly relevant results of work in progress, or successful systems and applications, in one of the three **Thematic Areas** of the Festival (User – Interface – Social Interaction).

Presenting a video during the Milano Design PhD Festival is a great opportunity to share your work, as well as to get feedback on it. Video Session will be an integral part of the Festival, with a specific session for **interactive discussion** between presenters and attendees. Note that, in order to maintain interactive and exciting Video Session, we require at least one presenter per accepted video to attend the Festival.

The official language of the Milano Design PhD Festival is **English**.

The **submission** must include an abstract (max 2000 characters) as well as all information about authors (Name, Surname, Institution, Position, email address and the Thematic Area) Please be aware that this document is mandatory and must be in PDF format with embedded fonts.

Abstracts will be printed in order to be visible during each thematic video session.

FORMAT

Duration: Maximum 60 sec, including movie credits (white text on black background). Everything beyond 60 seconds will be cut. Important: videos begin and end with a black screen.

File size: 720x576 pixels (PAL size). Maximum 100MB.

Audio: None.

Format: Videos should be exported in mov format.

Content: Please keep legal restrictions in mind (e.g. do not use footage or images which you are not entitled to distribute beyond fair use). The videos will be on display in a public place to a wide range of nationalities, so avoid causing offence. We reserve the right to withdraw videos we believe to be outside these guidelines.
